SHOW-FIELD REGULATIONS

- 1) **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE IN POSITION ON THE SHOW GROUND BY 9.15AM ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND MUST REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL 16.00. EXCESS VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY.**
- 2) No movement of vehicles is allowed during show times unless prior permission has been given, this includes leaving early - please speak to your section steward.
- 3) Each exhibit should hold a current **CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE**.
- 4) In the event of adverse weather, we ask for **NO** movement of vehicles on the show field except in the event of an emergency or by prior arrangement with the show management.
- 5) Anyone driving vehicles on the show site must display their pass, have a current full licence and adhere to the 5mph speed limit.
- 6) Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and all fouling disposed of properly.
- 7) Please clear all litter before leaving your site.
- 8) The discharge of firearms/dangerous weapons is strictly forbidden without prior approval.
- 9) Please use the designated tank for the disposal of chemical toilets. Emptying chemical toilets into the portaloos will not be accepted and may result in you being charged for emptying/cleaning.
- 10) Gazebos are not allowed in the Classic Car section. If you are using a gazebo elsewhere then it is **YOUR** responsibility to ensure that it is fixed securely at all times.
- 11) There is no smoking allowed in the social, craft and model areas.
- 12) There will be no unloading or loading of any exhibit after 22.00.
- 13) Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring any of their electrical equipment being connected to their generators are appropriately PAT tested in accordance with health and safety regulations.
- 14) Stall holders must provide their own fire extinguishers and first aid kits as required.
- 15) No loud music or noise permitted after 23.59.
- 16) No open campfires or disposable BBQs at any time. Any fire pits/BBQs **MUST** be raised off the ground.
- 17) If you wish to be pitched by a friend/relative please arrive together. Pitches will not be reserved unless arranged prior with the section steward.

STRICTLY NO ARRIVING BEFORE 12PM FRIDAY OF THE SHOW UNLESS BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT

Site MUST be vacated by 12pm on the Monday after the show!
